An engaging and sought-after speaker on issues around leadership, he is also well-known as a best-selling author, including of *Heroic Leadership: Best Practices from a 450-Year-Old Company that Changed the World* (2003), *Pope Francis: Why He Leads the Way He Leads* (2013) and *Everyone Leads: How to Revitalize the Catholic Church* (2017). Since 2013 he has been chair of the board of Catholic Health Initiatives, America's second largest not-for-profit healthcare system. He is the recipient of several honorary doctorates in recognition of his outstanding service, including through philanthropy and social entrepreneurship.
