



Before and After School Student Supervision Policy (Draft)

Saint Ignatius College Geelong provides teaching staff for student supervision **from 8.30am** until start of morning homeroom at 8.50am and then from 3.05pm **to 3.40pm** following afternoon homeroom.

With the exception of some bus travellers, it is expected that students will arrive at school no earlier than 8.30am and will have departed by no later than 3.20pm.

Before class supervision:

It is important to note that there will be supervision of some areas of the yard before and after school as indicated above and students are requested to follow supervision instructions:

From 8.30am until start of morning homeroom at 8.50am:

Some bus travellers, eg. Leopold bus route No. 1, arrive at school earlier than 8.30am. As the library will be open from 8.00am, these students are expected to go to the library upon arrival until at least 8.30am.

Sections of the school yard will be supervised from 8.30am until homeroom time. This will provide an opportunity for additional study time.

There are to be no ball games played before and after classes.

Upon arrival at school students must move straight to their year level precinct.

After class supervision:

From 3.05pm until 3.40pm:

It is also worth noting that the library will be open until 4.30pm most days - a good opportunity for study/research time for students waiting for late buses or senior student study.

Drop-off and Pick-up:

Please use the short-term carpark off Peninsula Drive to drop off or pick up your student(s).

No supervision of students is provided along Peninsula Drive, roadways and all out of bounds areas. Homeroom teachers have informed students about which areas are out of bounds.
